The international benchmark for sustainable paper

- Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Chain of Custody (CoC) is the highest and most trustworthy international certification for paper and timber products.
- FSC is well established internationally with 110 million hectares certified across 81 countries.*
- Forests are inspected and certified to strict standards and must be managed in an environmentally sound, socially beneficial and economically viable way.
- Buying FSC product supports the growth of responsible forest management worldwide.
- CoC is available to manufacturers who purchase or sell certified paper or wood and tracks the path taken by the raw material from the forest to the consumer.
- Finsbury Green, a certified company, purchases FSC certified paper from certified paper merchants to complete the chain of custody.
- Customers can publish the FSC trademark on printed product as a sign of their commitment to an environmentally preferable product. *(See Imprints the facts)*
- Ever increasing numbers of responsible companies and government agencies choose FSC certified paper and printers.
